

'Paine Project' Alleges Financial, Sexual Misconduct Among Paine Administrators

An anonymously maintained website, **'The Paine Project,'** has published a firestorm of allegations against Paine College and members of its executive leadership.

Accusations range from misuse of federal funds for child support payment, allegations of sexual harassment and assault, retaliatory termination and mismanagement of student aid funds.



Many allegations outlined on the site contain supporting memos and internal communications allegedly written and shared among Paine administrators and its board of trustees. Among the most startling charges: Excessive management and staff turnover, with **more than 28 officials having been terminated or resigning in the last six years**

Alleged **\$1.7 deficit in endowment disbursements** and **failure to adequately report to the Department of Education** on financial aid disbursements

Failure to rectify financial aid deficiencies **as required by the Department of Education**

Lack of transparency from George Bradley in **disclosing his candidacy for Southern University-Baton Rouge Chancellor vacancy.**

Legal history of sexual assault allegations against Board Vice-Chairman Kenneth Carter **which resulted in a civil suit judgment in 2012.**

Dr. Bradley did not respond to a request for comment as of press time
